UNIDENTIFIED FLYING OBJECTS

l. Mr. 20MM telephoned this Office wendering whether or not our Office had received any calls reporting sightings of unidentified flying objects. I advised Mr. 20MM that no such reports had been received. Mr. 20MM then reported that he had just spoken to his brother-in-law Edwin FUHR (B: 28 APR 38) on the telephone and he related to his how at around 10:30 A.M. today he came upon five (5) 'saucer shapped' objects while swathing rape at the above location. He apparently frome with fear and watched the 'Saucers' for apprex. 15 min. as they hovered about a foot off the ground. Finally he got off the Tracter and walked towards the 'Saucers' coming to within 20 ft. of them before they propelled straight up disapearing into the clouds. Mr. 20MM of course was skeptical as was I of the above story, however he advised that his brother-in-law is a responsible person and not prome to making up stories. Mr. 20MM also spoke to his father-in-law who returned to the scene of the sittings, and he confirmed that there were five definate circular patterns left in the swamp grass.

3. 2 SEP, I went to the scene with Mr. ZORN where we spoke with Edwin FUHR and examined the circular patterns left by the "Saucers". There were five different distinct circles, caused by something exerting what had to be heavy air or exhaust pressure over the highgrass. The grass was flattened in a clockwise circle with the flattened portion being approx. 18 in. The total dismetr of two of the circles was 12 ft., with the other three being approx 10 ft. in dismetre. The grass in the centre portion of the ring was standing, and appeared untouched. Photographs were taken of trings. FUHR stated that he was so involved with swathing in the rape, which was a good of ft. tell, that he didn't notice one of t "Saucers" located in the sunken dried slough in the field until he was about 50 ft. away from these. He described the Fau Cars as being about 4 or 5 ft. in height. The body was a highly polished
