PENDLETON, July 3.—(P)—The "saucers" still are flying over Pendleton.

Five Round-Up City residents reported seeing "six to eight" mysterious objects whiz over this area Tuesday afternoon.

Mrs. Walter Clark compared the "saucers" speed to that of a "shooting star." She added that they looked more like a "silver meat platter" than a saucer.

The objects were flying high and were visible only four or five minutes, the observers reported. They were traveling east.

Sunday, a McKay creek resident reported seeing objects similar to those reported by Kenneth Arnold, Boise, Idaho, flyer.

## Woman Reports Flying Saucers

MADRAS, July 3.—The "flying saucers," which were first sighted last week by a flyer, over the Washington Cascades, appeared Tuesday noon, according

to Mrs. R. A. Hunt, wife of Jefferson county's agricultural agent, in the sky over Madras.

Mrs. Hunt says she glimpsed them just after the noon blast of the fire department siren here had sounded, as she stepped from their home to await arrival of her husband for lunch. She said she counted six of the saucerlike objects, which shone like the surface of aluminum. She declares they were at extreme height. As she watched they circled like milling turkey buzzards and disappeared in the heights.

LEWISTON, Idaho, July 2.—(P)—Mrs. Lloyd Bergh said three members of her family and three neighbors Wednesday watched "flying saucers" whirling over Lewiston.

There were four of them, she said, white and shiny and flying very high. At times they dipped and rolled.

"Whatever they were and whatever they were doing," she said, "they seemed to be having fun."
